First and foremost, our entire team at Fesser and Friends would like to wish you and your family a happy holiday season as we enter the winter months ahead. As friends and families unite all over the world to share the holidays with their loved ones, we are also reminded of those who do not have such a privilege, in particular the children at our orphanage in Democratic Republic of the Congo. Hope is not all lost, however, as we are continuing to provide them with love and nourishment that they so desperately need and deserve. Over the course of the last year, we have made incredible progress which I

hope to share with you today.

In the last twelve months we have been named Beni's best run orphanage by the state's department of social affairs (DIVAS), reunited 5 children with their biological families, have reenrolled students in the best school in the city, filmed a documentary about conflict in the Congo, rebuilt the plumbing and electricity of the orphanage, expanded our chicken farm to house over 200 chickens, initiated a project to help single mothers pay for the costs of pregnancy and childbirth to promote maternal and neonatal health, and have made important strides towards ending the cycle of child soldier recruitment.
